## Meeting of Lamphey Community Council meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2021

The following topics were discussed and the following decisions were made:-

- Cllr T Hodgson had also been in touch with the Neighbourhood Police Team who would monitor cars parking on the pavement in Lamphey near to the Dial.

- A meeting to be arranged between LCC, Chris Taylor of PCNP and other members of the Freshwater East liaison committee. The Clerk to contact Chris Taylor again and find out what dates he is available.
- A meeting with representatives from the Church would be arranged in the New Year to discuss the burial ground once the Covid restrictions had been eased.
- Defibrillators Cllr R Tallis had made an application and had received an acknowledgement. Awaiting further information from Western Power and Highways.
- Tree Planting the land by Honeyhill may be a suitable site. Enquiries to be made on who owns the land.
- After setting the budget the precept was set at £14,250.00 for the year 2022/2023
- Planning application NP/21/0757 Glen, Freshwater East. Although the Community Council have no objection LCC would like to see a restriction included which would state that the garage is ancillary to the house and not a separate dwelling.
- Local Government (Wales) Act 2021 information had been sent out and the training arrangements would be the responsibility of the new Council after May 2022.
- Jubilee Funding would be discussed at next month's meeting.
