II. Receive and confirm minutes of last meeting dated 12/11/14. Signed by Chair.

III. Matters arising

- b) Angle Beach – overnight parking.

- c) Byway, Pointhouse Road – Check on progress of councils concern that the gabions are not high enough and the filling in them is too small and is being washed away with each high tide. Teresa to follow up.
- d) Angle School Safety Measures – An email received from Alan Hunt from PCC regarding the proposed modifications outside Angle School to improve safety for the children. A suggestion was to look into a payment method (i.e. coin operated) for the use of these toilets to help with costs.
- Email – received from Sharon Rogers regarding the Councils views on TB breakdown info publication. At present, the Council stated no reason to change the existing policy.
- Community Transport – ACC have been asked by PACTO (Pembrokeshire Association of Community Transport Organisation) to bring to the attention of all residence in Angle and surrounding areas of their facilities available. Leaflets with further information are available in Angle Village Shop.
