- (b) during the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the community named above; or
- (c) your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the community named above; or
- (d) you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the Community or with 4.8 kilometres of it.

Certain people are disqualified from standing, and these include paid officers of the Community Council, anyone subject to bankruptcy restriction orders and those subject to recent sentences of imprisonment. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that they are qualified to stand.
