1. West Angle Bay emergency issues

Cllrs Ward, Watkins and Howells met with PCNPA on the 12th August 2022 to discuss issues with the access leading to "Big Dock". PCNPA are happy to assist with any clearing of bushes and shrubs once permission has been granted from the land owner.

Buoyancy aids have been replaced in the car park area via Cllr Ward; discussions are on-going to obtain another to be sited at "Big Dock".

The request to reinstate an emergency telephone at the beach is underway with support from the ambulance service and Sam Kurtz. Advice received from the Office of Rt Hon Simon Hart MP to make a request to PCC via County Councillor Alderman to see if there are plans to install an emergency telephone at West Angle or if they'd be willing to provide one via their telecommunications provider.
