

## **Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of Lamphey Community Council held on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022 held at Lamphey Village Hall at 7.00 pm**

### **2. Declarations of Interest**

### **3. To discuss arranging a community fire work display on the 4th November 2022.**

Cllr J Purser reported that he had met with Sam Nichols who was a representative from Paynes Fireworks to inspect the far end of the playing fields to make sure it is a suitable site. Paynes have all the necessary insurance documents to comply with regulations.

The cost would be in the region of £2,000 + vat for a 12/15 minute display.

The Swinging Nettles would cost £150 for the evening.

Cllr R Talliss queried if Paynes had a cancellation policy.

Cllr J Purser suggested using some of the funds from the Enhanced Pembrokeshire Grant as well as some of the Council funds.

Admission – Suggested £15 per family - £10 per couple.

Cllr L Scourfield was concerned that people would stand on the road and watch the fireworks and not pay to come onto the field to watch the display.

Cllr N Vince reported that he had experience from his involvement with other organisations and suggested pre-selling tickets.

Suggested registering with Event Bite to pre-sell tickets. The Clerk to looking into setting this up and look into the terms and conditions.

After discussion it was proposed by Cllr L Scourfield and seconded by Cllr M Colley to proceed with this event and look into the event in more detail at the next meeting.

Cllr A Skeels advised the meeting that he still thought there was funds ring fenced from previous years.

Ideally the event should break even or make a small amount of money to carry forward to the next event.

Cllr Scourfield suggested setting up a subcommittee to organise the event. Cllr R Talliss told the meeting that the Community Association had about 20 people attend the last meeting and perhaps this was an opportunity to tie both committees together.

The sub-committee would consist of Cllr L Scourfield, Cllr J Purser, Cllr L Scourfield, Cllr R Talliss and Cllr M Colley
