



Minutes – Angle Community Council Meeting, Wednesday 2nd November 2022

1. Approval of minutes from meeting held 5th October 2022 – Agreed by all, signed off by Cllr Williams, chair

2. Agenda items

1. Action points from last meeting.

1. West Angle Bay emergency issues. - The Angle estate are happy for the phone at the caravan site to be used for emergencies however Cllr Ward has notified them that it is not working. The estate will investigate
2. Playpark update - Cllr Howells unavailable but no further feedback from PCC since email of 5th October
3. Notice board update - Cllr Williams has emailed PCNPA to clarify planning implications, now awaiting clarification from PCC. Forms almost completed
4. Cost of living impacts for the community. -Cllr Williams has been in touch with the Village Hall committee, who are in support of applying for a warm space community grant. Application deadline is 9th Nov with start date at the end of November if successful.
5. Housing issues -Vacant Council Houses - Cllr Ward reported that delays are due to availability of contractor to be upgraded to the best possible energy efficiency standards. They have been prioritised
6. Council Garages at Mirehouse Place - Cllr Ward reported that PCC are proceeding with refurbishment / repair of existing garages, but no indication of time line. Allocation of garages is via a system called Northgate, with council tenants having first refusal, even if they apply later than a private applicant.

2. Councillor / Clerk vacancies – Cllr Williams reported that an expression of interest had been made regarding the clerical post with a likely application to follow.

3. Newsletter submission – circulated article approved by all. Cllr Williams will submit
