37.21 RUDBAXTON COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION.

Thanks was given to the Community Council for financial assistance with regards to the toilet provision over the summer. The Park is a well-used facility, and the toilet provision is very much welcomed.

The association now have rubbish collection provision in the form of several wheelie bins, which is being monitored and at present is working well. It is highlighted that the community play area is monitored and cleaned by a small group of volunteers and for that the council thank and appreciate the service.

Fundraising is ongoing as work is required to replace or replace some sections of the play park. Grant and monies are being sought and SVD enquired with Cllr Yelland as to the availability of section 106 monies and also from second home tax. Cllr Yelland will look further into this for the association.
