Minutes of the meeting of Stackpole and Castlemartin Community Council held at Bosherston Church Hall on Monday, July 18th 2022, at 7.30pm.

#### **Update on current issues**

- 1. Sustainable Freshwater west Councillor Edward Morris is to email Stuart Berry to discuss the sustainable freshwater West project.
- 2. St. Twynnells Bus Shelter Rod Thomas has now retired from Pembrokeshire County Council property department; property is recruiting for new surveyors once the recruitment drive is complete the case will be passed onto the new person in post. There was no further update at the time of the meeting.
- 3. Parking Freshwater West, Bosherston, Stackpole Quay A meeting has taken place with Councillor Edward Morris, Councillor Steve Alderman, Nicola Gandy of Pembrokeshire Coast, Marc Owen from Pembrokeshire County Council and Rhian Sula from the National Trust. It was agreed that the sand like substance will be removed, Marc Owen is to arrange the removal. There will be a Further meeting in August to see how the summer has been. The 28-day rule will be monitored. In Bosherston it is going to see if it can be negotiated with Pembrokeshire County Council to open the field belonging to Simon Davies using the 28-day rule. The councillors asked the clerk to arrange the meeting in August.
- **4. Stackpole Church Hall** No further developments hoping to advertise for a new vicar in July 22 the bishop is planning to advertise the post. There was no further update at the time of the meeting.
- 5. Notice Board Stackpole There was no further update at the time of the meeting. Councillor Haydn Garlick will reinstate the noticeboard in the current location outside the former Stackpole VC School. The councillors asked the clerk to enquire if planning permission is required to erect the notice board on the former site of the telephone kiosk.
- **6.** Thorn Chapel sign The sign has now been installed. The community councillors asked the clerk to email the camp and request signage to show when the times and dates when the army are firing. The camp has provided an email with the firing times however the councillors would like a sign erected as people are still trying to drive to Stack Rocks when the road is closed. The councillors asked the clerk to contact Major Poole again.
- 7. Clerk CILCA Course The clerk has submitted the assignments for level 2 for assessment and is awaiting the results.
- **8.** Road drop at Café Mor The road drop at café Mor in Freshwater West has now been repaired.
- **9. Bosherston Speed limit** The councillors asked the clerk to contact Pembrokeshire County Council and request a 30mph from the church bungalow to the village. Claire Williams of Pembrokeshire County Council is organising the speed checks are required in Bosherston and Stackpole. The results have returned all under 30mph.
- **10. Warren Cross sign** The sign at Warren Cross to St. Twynnells is missing. The matter has now been passed to Emrys Llewelyn of PCC who has ordered a new direction sign to St. Twynnells. At the time of the meeting the sign has yet to be replaced.
- **11.St. Twynnells Speed Limit sign –** Claire Williams of Pembrokeshire County Council has organised monitoring equipment which has been completed in St. Twynnells. The results have returned all under 30mph.
- **12. Playground funding equipment and insurance –** The Service Level Agreement is now in place with Pembrokeshire County Council and Pembrokeshire County Council are now cutting the grass and maintaining the equipment.

- **13. Bosherston No Coaches Sign** Rob Evans of Pembrokeshire County Council is Arranging for an unsuitable for coaches sign to be installed near Windsor House at the village end of the road to the beach. The councillors asked the clerk to chase up the erection of the signage.
- **14. White Salt like substance fly tipped at Freshwater West –** marc Owen of Pembrokeshire County Council is going to arrange for the removal of the salt like substance.
- **15. Presence of elderly pedestrians** Councillor Edward Morris enquired about a sign for Chapel Hill which is costed at £49 plus VAT. As Chapel Hill is in the Hundleton ward the councillors asked the clerk to write to Hundleton Community Council clerk about sign. Hundleton community council has written to Pembrokeshire County Council requesting signage
- **16. Meadow Bank, St. Twynnells, Lighting Bollards** Councillor Billy Evans reported that the lighting bollards outside the bungalows in meadow bank are eon day and night and asked the clerk to report the matter to Pembrokeshire County Council. The bollards have now been turned off during the day, however the light outside number 8 woodland Rise is now missing.
- **17.Code of Conduct Training** Joint community council code of conduct training has been arranged for Stackpole & Castlemartin, Hundleton and Angel community councillors.
- 18. Castlemartin Army Camp Councillor Edward Morris asked that the clerk contact Major Poole of Castlemartin army camp and ask that please can he speak to his drivers as they are not stopping at school crossing lights.
- **19.ST. Petrox** The councillors also asked the clerk to write to St. Petrox farm for feedback as there was a major accident where the road narrows and the community council feel signage would be of benefit in this area.
