One vacancy Saundersfoot North Ward

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that one vacancy has occurred in the Office of Councillor for the above-mentioned Community Ward, and the Community Council intends to co-opt. Expressions of interest are being sought from members of the public who meet the following qualifications and are interested in representing their community.

You must be at least 18 years old, a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of any member state of the European Union or a qualifying foreign citizen, and meet at least one of the following criteria:*

- Registered as a local government elector for the area named above, or
- During the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the community named above; or
- Your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the community named above; or
- You have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the Community or within 4.8 kilometres of it.

*Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972 outlines the disqualifications for standing as a Community Councillor. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that they are qualified to stand.
