d) To receive feedback from a meeting regarding the Community Review (possible changes to Community Councils)

The Clerk informed the meeting that a review is underway of communities and their councils. This could affect Manordeifi as it is a very small community council.

8. Planning Applications (for comment or information)

a) **23/0332/PA** Proposal: Change of use from agricultural use to dog exercise field with erection of fence and shed in retrospect. The construction of a new access and alterations to existing parking and turning arrangements and the erection of additional fence with landscaping treatments.*Amended Plans/Statements*

Site Address: Fynnone Dog Field, Newchapel, Pembrokeshire, SA37 0EH

Councillors expressed their concern regarding the entrance being unsafe as it opens out on to a 60mph road with another junction opposite that leads to 7 properties (with the lane being used by agricultural vehicles). Now the evenings are getting dark earlier, torches are being used by dog walkers which is unfair on residents. A 360 degree camera is encroaching on residential properties which is recording sound. This is a worry to residents. Hopefully this issue has been flagged up to the enforcement officers. Councillors are being personally insulted by residents over the issue. This is unacceptable.

RESOLVED: to write another letter to planning including information on operating hours, the number of dogs using the field at any one time, the issue of the camera and the danger of the access.

b) 23/0409/PA Proposal: Two-storey extension to dwelling

Site Address: Tair Sir, Abercych, Boncath, Pembrokeshire, SA37 0EX

The footpath that runs by the property has a gate across it and the signage is missing. County Cllr Ward will follow this up. The planning notice was not visible but is now, although it is opposite the house and looks as though it relates to the sheds being built.

Cllr Parsons reported concerns from 4 Abercych residents living near the 'Tair Sir' proposal, that the extension is not in keeping with the vernacular style of properties near 'Tair Sir'. Furthermore, concerns were also expressed that other recent residential planning applications in Abercych, have been refused by PCC due to phosphate levels in River Teifi. Residents have been advised to put their comments forward to the planning department.

RESOLVED: not to comment on the planning application as a council RESOLVED: to create a policy for approaching planning applications to ensure parity
