Community Councillors discussed the issue with extra cars on that stretch of road due to the new Redhill school and diversions around the new A470 road developments.

Cllrs expressed the issues around the speed of the cars (related to the school traffic in particular). Community members are not walking their children on the road due to the dangers.

Clerk to write a letter to Redhill school expressing the concerns of the Community Council.
