1. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 8th May 2014 were passed as a true record.
Proposed by Cllr Philpin and seconded by Cllr Davey.

2. CHAIRMANS REPORT.

The Chairman reported that it had been an eventful year with both positives and negatives.
The positive aspects for the year had seen a defibrillator being located in the village, the refurbishment of the crossing at Sandy Haven had benefited both Herbrandston and St Ishmaels.
Gates on the footpath had been erected along with new village signs.

Local village activities had been supported, the carnival, fireworks, Christmas tree, hall heating and the burial ground.

The main negative factor was the closure of Murco oil refinery, which had affected many local families, also the fact that South Hook CHP project did not materialise meant that the promised funding for the play area would not be available. The other concern was the non development of the Sir Benfro sire.

Cllr Lloyd then thanked the councillors for their support during the year.

3. CLERKS REPORT.

The Clerk gave a summary of the annual financial report which had been presented at a previous council meeting. This was accepted by the meeting.
