- Speeding issues through the villages – Wales Road Casualty Reduction Unit - surveying Tavernspite to see if bumps are having a good effect. If there is speeding there could be some action. Still 40mph in Princes Gate and Ludchurch – trying to get it reduced but police will not enforce.
- Tanners Lane will be closed Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Feb for 5 weeks.
- Gilfach Hill – there is 16ft 6in clearance of overhanging trees in the middle of the road. Will look at it again in the New Year.
