1036 <u>County Councillors' report</u>

Roch school will have 150 on roll by January 2015.

Work will be undertaken to improve passing places on Nolton lanes.

Consideration is being given to a relief road by-passing Newgale. Damage will be repaired on the roads used during the recent diversions and there will be a gradual upgrading or re-prioritization of another route.

1037 Flashing Speedlights

Clerk read out advices received from Solva Community Council and Llandewi Velfrey Community Council regarding their experiences of implementing flashing speedsigns. It was felt by some councillors that perhaps improved road markings may prove just as effective. Councillor J Adams suggested contacting the Safety Camera Partnership GO SAFE about adopting Roch for safety monitoring.
