Four members of the public were in attendance. A request was made by two members of the public as to whether the bonfire this year can be sited further over on the playing field following concerns regarding embers being blown into properties in Fiddlers Lane. It was agreed to move the bonfire further across the field as the cricket pitch is no longer being maintained to county standards.

A member of the public expressed concerns that there is no sign at the top of the village warning that the road is unsuitable for large vehicles.

Mr Hugh Morgan wanted to express his concerns with regard to traffic problems within the village and the on-going issue of dog fouling. This will be discussed at next meeting when County Cllr Kidney is present.
