## Minutes of the meeting of Templeton Community Council

## Held in the Templeton Hall, Templeton on 31st May 2018

Cllr Morgan welcomed everyone to the meeting.

- 1) To accept apologies for absence. No apologies were received.
- 2) To disclose personal and pecuniary interests in the items listed below. None were declared.

It was agreed to also put a copy on the website and on the Facebook page. The Clerk was requested to send an invoice for the advertisement that had been included in the newsletter.

Cllr Morse expressed his thanks to the Council for permitting the Hall furniture to be used by the Royal Welsh fundraising committee.
