Minutes of Annual Meeting held Wednesday 9th May 2018

- 1. Apologies for absence. Cllr Meurig James and County Cllr David Simpson had offered their apologies.
- 2. Election of chair for coming year. After brief discussion Cllr Jamie Lewis was proposed by Cllr Griffiths and seconded by Cllr Eynon, and all present agreed.
- 3. Election of vice chair for coming year. After brief discussion Cllr Tudor Eynon was proposed by Cllr Lewis and seconded by Cllr Thomas, and all present agreed.
- 4. Minutes of previous annual meeting. These had been previously circulated. They were accepted as correct, and agreed by all after this was proposed by Cllr Eynon and seconded by Cllr Griffiths.
- 5. Matters arising from previous meeting. It was agreed that there were no matters arising from these minutes.
- 6. Financial report annual governance statement and statement of accounts. These were circulated and reviewed. After a discussion they were agreed as accurate and accepted proposed by Cllr Lewis, seconded by Cllr Griffiths and agreed by all.
