MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 6th SEPTEMBER 2018

78. QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC.

Cllr George invited Mr & Mrs Mills to address the meeting. Mr Mills complained about the speed of vehicles travelling through the 40mph speed limit in Dreen Hill. He felt unsafe at times to pull out of his drive due the excessive speed. Cllr Rowlands said that he was aware of the problem and would raise it at the Police Forum the following week. Cllr George suggested using Community Speed Watch and seeing if PCC would carry out a speed survey. It was also suggested that the matter be reported to the Road Policing Unit at Haverfordwest. Cllr George said that PCC would require facts before taking action. Mr Mills also mentioned that overhanging tree branches were obstructing signs at Skerrybrook Bridge. Clerk would contact PCC.
