Qualifications to be a Community Councillor

A person is qualified to be elected and to be a Councillor if they are a British, Commonwealth, Irish or European Union Citizen and on the relevant day (that is, the day of nomination or election (13th February 2019)) they are 18 or over (qualifying age was reduced by section 17 of the 2006 Electoral Administration Act).

In addition, the person must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- (1) on the relevant day (13^{th} February 2019) they must be on the electoral register for the community, or
- (2) during the whole of the twelve months before that day they have occupied as owner or tenant land or premises in the community $\frac{1}{2}$
- (3) during the whole of the twelve months before that day their principal or only place of work has been in the community
- (4) during the whole of the twelve months before that day they have resided in the community or within three miles of it.
