7. HIGHWAYS & RIGHTS OF WAY.

Moorland Road.

Cllr Thomas said that following on from the matters raised by members of the public at the last meeting he had sent a note to the business premises on Moorland Road pointing out the problems raised by residents. He had also written to PCC asking them to mark Slow on the road and erect signs as a matter of urgency.

Cllr M. John said that all parties had been made aware of the issues.

Cllr Thomas said there a loose manhole cover near Maddox Moor which had been reported to PCC.

Layby near Puddleduck. Cllr Thomas said he had visited the location but due to the adverse weather had not spoken to the lady who had raised the issue. Cllr R. John proposed that a dustbin should be placed at the location. This was agreed. The Clerk would email PCC with the request. (Copy to Cllr M. John.)

9. VILLAGE HALL.

Cllr Thomas said that he applied to Welsh Water for a grant towards the Village Hall and the hall had been awarded £250. He proposed that the money be used for replacing the four heaters in the hall. This was agreed by the meeting.

Cllr Thomas said that the quotation for the drainage work at the playing field had been prepared by a local contractor at the request of Welsh Water.
