5. ANY OTHER BUSINESS.

1. Cllr Davey presented a request from the church asking for a donation towards the cost of a new mower to cut the grass in the burial ground. The chosen mower would cost £1,500.

Cllr Davey then retired from the meeting.

Following a discussion it was agreed that the council would purchase the mower and claim back the VAT. The Church would make a £700 contribution towards the cost of the mower.

2. Cllr Philpin said that noisy tankers were returning to SHLNG time after time, despite having notices served on them. He asked Cllr Lloyd to raise the matter at the next liaison meeting in SHLNG. Cllr Lloyd said that the next meeting was due to be held next month. Following a discussion it was agreed that Cllr Lloyd would raise the matter at the next liaison meeting and report back to the council. Invite a technical representative from SHLNG to attend a council meeting to discuss the matter further. This was agreed.

3. Cllr Tilling said that he had received complaints of vehicles parking outside Rock Cottage. The Clerk said that he had contacted the Police after the last meeting. He would contact them again.

4. Cllr Lloyd said that Cllr Owens had suggested giving commemorative royal wedding mugs to the village children. Cllr Owens said that commemorative mugs was a tradition in the village and he felt that the council should proceed with this matter. The Clerk said that he had obtained a design and price from the internet, the mugs would also have “presented by Herbrandston Community Council” on the back. The mugs would be given to all children under the age of 16. It was proposed by Cllr Davey and seconded by Cllr Lloyd that we proceed with this matter. The Clerk to arrange ordering the mugs and payment.
