Minutes of the meeting of Stackpole and Castlemartin Community Council held at Castlemartin Community Hall on Monday, June 4th 2018, at 7.30pm.

Update on current issues

- 1. **Dip in the road at Stackpole:** PCC will arrange for this to be cut out and reinstated. This has still not been done and the councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up yet again.
- 2. Freshwater West Bridge: Sign at the top of the hill at freshwater West New signs indicating that the road is unsuitable for both longer and wide vehicles have recently been installed at either end of this road together with narrow road signs.
- 3. **Pembroke Comprehensive Bus Route -** Councillor David Edwards asked the clerk to contact Pembroke Comprehensive School and see if the rural bus route covering Stackpole could be changed as pupils from Stackpole are on the bus for one hour in the morning and one hour in the evening. The councillors asked the clerk to contact Tess Hodgson. Hodgson.
- 4. **Deerpark View -** Councillor Peter Nicholas asked the clerk to contact the highways department at Pembrokeshire County Council to re fix the road sign for Deerpark View next to the bus stop as it is barely hanging on. An order has been given to manufacture and install a new sign to replace the existing one.
- 5. Stackpole VC School sale no news.
- St. Twynells Bus Shelter Councillor Edward Morris asked the clerk to contact Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council in relation to repairs required at St. Twynells bus shelter. The building maintenance team have been asked to inspect the bus shelter and carry out any necessary repairs.
- 7. **Hayston Lane -**The councillors asked the clerk to write to Castlemartin army camp to put a sign up for Hayston Lane as army vehicles are going up to Hayston.
- 8. **Penrhyn School Zebra Crossing -** The councillors asked the clerk to contact Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council and request a pedestrian crossing and lollipop person to assist the children to cross the road at the new Penrhyn School. The raised crossing work will be carried out during the summer break to avoid conflict with school traffic during term time.
