Update on current issues

- 1. **Stackpole VC School -** sale no news. The councillors asked the clerk to write again and enquire as to what is happening.
- 2. St. Twynells Bus Shelter The building maintenance team have been asked to inspect the bus shelter and carry out any necessary repairs. No news at the date of the meeting. Email received from Owen Roberts of PCC stating that due to the estimated cost of repairs and the very low usage of the shelter, PCC are unable to justify the repair of the shelter and propose that it is demolished. The Councillors asked the clerk to write back to Owen Roberts and inform him that the community definitely do not want the shelter demolished and ask that if PCC finances can't repair the shelter at the moment then the community would be prepared to wait for a few more years. The councillors asked if the village raised the funds would PCC allow the shelter to be repaired by the village.
- 3. **Hayston Lane -**The councillors asked the clerk to write to Castlemartin army camp to put a sign up for Hayston Lane as army vehicles are going up to Hayston. No further update at the time of the meeting.
- **4. Councillor Andrew Evans** has resigned. As a result of Councillor Andrew Evans resignation, we now have a vacancy for a community Councillor for the Stackpole & Castlemartin area. The council will invite people to apply for co-option with a closing date of Friday the 30th November 2018.
- 5. **Street Light -** 9031656 outside number 1 Deerpark View is still not working and the street light above Deerpark View is on all the time. This light is now not working at all the councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up with the highways department.
