It was agreed to discuss the new road alignment on Angle Road to Valero prior to our business meeting.

Firstly Mr Thornton advised that this scheme whilst at the request of Valero was in fact a PCC planning application. In addition to the road realignment there were requests to lower speed limit at this point to 30mph increasing to 50mph plus traffic calming. Valero have tried to educate their staff re speeding for their own and others safety. The new layout was designed by PCC to be passed by the Safety Audit team, there was also now a possibility of Sensor Traffic Lights for traffic from Angle to Pembroke

Cllr. Eric Scourfield asked why a simple STOP SIGN for Valero traffic could not have been used thus saving a great deal of money.

Cllr Jonathon Williams drives a mini bus with 16 young children collecting them from Angle and returning them each school day, he constantly has motorist rushing to or from Valero and The Power Station overtaking him flashing their lights sadly the mini bus is not fitted with a Dash Cam.

Cllr.Dai Callan suggested a roundabout.

Mr Thornton advised that all possibilities would be looked at and suggested we invite representatives from PCC to our next meeting he would also attend if we wished.
