PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL: LEADER'S CORONAVIRUS UPDATE, WEDNESDAY 25TH MARCH

Pembrokeshire County Council Leader, Councillor David Simpson, has provided a further coronavirus update for Wednesday 25th March, as follows:

'We continuing to put in place the necessary actions arising from the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday evening (23rd March) including today:

- the suspension of all but essential safety maintenance works on our highway network. Operatives will be called to attend to any emergency work or urgent repairs
- parks and gardens remain open but with signage proposed to highlight 'no gatherings'
- playgrounds, sports grounds and pitches are closing
- forty-seven of our 68 public toilets will be closed. Only 21 will remain open.

'I want to stress again that you should stay at home, except for essential activities

'We will be taking steps to ensure that our own staff - or those working for us - who need to be in their workplace or helping in the community as key workers, will possess the necessary identification to confirm their status.
