

Meeting Minutes - Angle Community Park Committee Meeting 18th February 2020 Angle Village Hall @ 6.30pm

1. Fundraising

There are a few events possible for fundraising in the next few months. Ideas discussed further with a view to expand and take action.

Easter Egg Run/Hunt – 12th April

Fairytale Celebrations to be contacted to enquire about booking a visit from them for the Easter Sunday. They provide an entertainer dressed up as the Easter bunny to entertain the children.

Other plans include an Easter bonnet parade, Mrs Mirehouse may like to judge. Entries to be judged within two categories, under 5 year olds and over 5 year olds. Prizes for best bonnets comprise of a cuddly toy for the under 5 years category and a £10 cash prize for the over 5 years category.

The Easter egg hunt will comprise of a set of clues that will lead to the main prize. Each person who enters will receive a reward at the end, each entry to pay £1.

There will also be a game of Easter bingo. Prizes will hopefully consist of smaller Easter eggs for line winners and larger Easter eggs for house winners.

Order of events and costing of bingo games to be confirmed at a later date.

Action points:

- 2. Emma to contact Mrs Mirehouse to ask if she is willing and able to judge the Easter bonnet parade
- 3. Becky James to create a set of clues for the hunt and send to Emma Howells to design and print.
- 4. Laura Powell to ask for donations of Easter eggs to use as prizes and Emma Howells will source bingo cards.
- 5. Emma Howells to create advertising collateral and advertise on social media.

VE Day Celebrations – 8th May 2020

Ideas discussed for VE Day are as follows:

Unveiling of the World War II memorial plaques.

Memorabilia from local residents of the village could be showcased in the village hall. Arequest for such memorabilia will be published in the next newsletter. George Greer could aslo be approached to ask if he would be willing to either provide wartime relics or allow free entry at Chapel Bay Fort.

The Hibernia to provide refreshments from their mobile bar. Licensing requirements need to be checked with them.

BBQ – Proceeds from the sale of burgers and hotdogs will go towards the park.

Mike Brotherton to be contacted to ask if he would be willing to speak at the event.

A 1930's/1940's style fancy dress parade from the beach was suggested, along with a dance group for entertainment.

Live music.

1940's style games, hopscotch etc.

1940's style photo booth.

Baking competition – egg less cakes. Cakes could then be auctioned to raise money – proceeds to go to the play park fund.

Raffle.

Bouncy castle.

This event is planned to take place in Angle football field. The owner Andrew Thomas has given permission verbally to use the space for fundraising events for the play park, however, he needs to be contacted to give assurance that this is still ok.

Insurance details for the event also need to be investigated further to ensure all items are covered.

- 1. Emma Howells to approach Kath Lunn for details on the mobile bar and purchasing burgers and sausages from wholesalers. Licensing details to be discussed.
- 2. Emma Howells to contact Mike Brotherton to ask if he would be willing to speak at the event.
- 3. Emma Howells to research dance groups in the area.
- 4. Becky James to make enquiries for live music.
- 5. Laura Powell to request donations for raffle prizes.
- 6. Laura Powell to enquire with bouncy castle firms.
- 7. Emma Howells to contact Andrew Thomas for written permission to use the football field.
- 8. Shan Williams to contact George Greer regarding war time relics and entry to Chapel Bay Fort.
- 9. Emma Howells to create posters and graphics for digital advertising of the event.

Angle Village Fete – 25th July 2020

The Angle village fete is being organised by Sarah Hirst and she wants to donate a share of the proceeds to Angle play park. In return she has asked for hands on help from the committee on the day. Those in attendance at the meeting agreed to help out on the day. Other committee members unable to attend tonight's meeting need to be asked.

<u>New Year's Day Swim – 1st January 2021</u> - We have been approached by Jo Lutwytche to join the New Year's Day swim event in 2021. Proceeds will be divided between Angle Community Park and the Paul Sartori Foundation. Volunteers will be needed for this event and further discussion will take place in forthcoming meetings, one of which Jo will attend to elaborate on what is needed from us.

2. Play Park Equipment - Wicksteed

Revised costings and designs will be distributed when received from Wicksteed.

Shan Williams has managed to obtain a Welsh Water map showing the services in the area. This is a great start. Wicksteed will need to see copies of all buried services when requested.
