**254 12/2020** To receive the Minutes of the meeting held 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020 in Jameston Village Hall Car Park

Cllr Long proposed that the draft Minutes of the Full Council Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020 be accepted as a true and correct record. Cllr Clark seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

**256 12/2020** Consideration of any correspondence

- The Clerk advised the Council that various correspondences were still being received from one individual – all requests for information have been answered to the best of the Clerks ability.

**257 12/2020** To consider the 2021/2022 Precept and Budget

All Councillors agreed that they had received a copy of the proposed budget and all financial information prior to the meeting.

Prior to discussing the proposed budget Cllrs considered the financial information, as presented to Councillors. Cllr Long proposed that the financial report be signed by the Chair as a true and accurate record of the Manorbier Community Council's finances up to the 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020; Cllr Clark seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

Following a discussion regarding the proposed budget, Cllr Kidney proposed that Manorbier Community Council accept the budget as presented for 2021/2022 and to request a Precept of £12,260.00 from the Pembrokeshire County Council; Cllr Long seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

**258 12/2020** Planning Considerations update

The Clerk confirmed that the planning application for Buttyland's Caravan park and affordable housing was to be considered by the Planning Committee.

**259 12/2020** To consider the Play Ground/s Risk Assessment for adoption by the Manorbier Community Council

Cllr Clark proposed the Manorbier Community Council accept and adopt the Play Ground/s risk assessment; Cllr Kidney seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

**260 12/2020** To consider a letter of support to the Manorbier Community Hall fund raising group and pledge a further donation amount and when it should be awarded.

Following discussion regarding the on-going project and the funding thereof, Cllr Kidney proposed the Manorbier Community Council offer a letter advising that the Council will make a further donation of £5,000 when the building is near completion; Cllr Long seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.
