

Meeting of Lamphey Community Council held on July 27th 2021

In attendance were :- Cllr N Vince, Cllr S Cannon, Cllr J Vince, Cllr J Purser, Cllr A Skeels, Cllr L Scourfield, Cllr D Phillips, and Cllr H John

The following decisions were made:-

- Letter to be sent to the Chief Executive, Director of Planning of Pembroke Coast National Park Authority expressing the Council's concern at the recent decision to grant planning permission on Plot 5 Devon Court, Freshwater East.
- The Accounts as circulated were approved and Cllr S Cannon, Cllr N Vince and the Clerk to complete the audit forms.
- Payments were approved to the Clerk, HMRC and One Voice Wales (Training costs)
- Meetings could now take place in the Committee room of Lamphey Village Hall from September.
- Updates on Highways matters which included grass cutting, maintenance issues, and speed signs were received from the County Councillor.
- No Objection - NP/21/0389 – Via Maris, Jason Road (installation of first floor windows and roof light, alterations to fenestration, removal of chimney)
- No objection - NP/21/0443 – 296 & 297 Trewent Park (replacement of flat roof to pitched roof including external cladding)
- Lamphey Community Council to object to - 21/0298/PA Meadow Lodge, South of Meadow Gardens, Lamphey, Pembroke, SA71 5NS - Change of use of land with siting of timber lodge, ancillary timber studio building, timber decking and garden.
- The Council to submit two applications under the Highways Fund for two speed awareness signs. The two sites that were discussed as suitable were the road from Westhill into Lamphey and the road coming into Lamphey from Hodgeston past the School.
- The Community Council discussed the recent request received via the Freshwater East arts community for funding towards a new noticeboard and after discussion the community Council decided that they couldn't support this application.
- The Community Council approved the Clerk's request to join the SLCC.
- Resolved to write to PCNP to make them aware of recent instances when the slipway had been blocked and ask them to monitor the situation.
- The following items to be listed on the September Agenda:-
Hall Heating, new pavement near Honeyhill, Enhancing Pembroke Grant and possible new application, Christmas Meal, Risk Assessment, Highways Funding, Bank Account, Report from the County Councillor.
