82. Pembrokeshire County Council Precept information 2022/23. After discussion Gareth Johnson proposed and Enid Cole seconded to make an application to raise the precept to £6,000 a year. Helen to complete relevant paperwork.

84. Invoice from Dylan Evans for Grass cutting around the Village. Invoice for £35.00. Before discussion Helen Evans and Ceirwyn John declared an interest in the matter. Lon Davies proposed and Ieuan Davies seconded for the payment to be made.

88. Nevern Enhancing Pembrokeshire Grant. We have received a letter from Wyn Harries on behalf of Nevern Show regarding a contribution from the Eglwyswrw grant allocated. Helen has confirmation that the allocation for Eglwyswrw has been used to pay for a sound system etc for the Community Hall.
89. Pembrokeshire County Council Planning decision, Plas Y Coed, Eglwyswrw. Application has been conditionally approved for extension to existing dwelling comprising of garage, utility room and WC and all associated works.
90. Pembrokeshire County Council Planning decision. Treclynfa, Eglwyswrw for external works to ancillary accommodation (in retrospect) This is conditionally approved.
91. Pembrokeshire County Council – Planning application Heol Yr Eglwys, Eglwyswrw. Proposed residential development and associated works. There is still a huge concern regarding this development.
