Certain people are disqualified from standing, they include paid officers of the community council, anyone subject to bankruptcy restriction orders and those subject to recent sentences of imprisonment.

Be at the 'grass roots' of local government and be involved in making things happen or getting things sorted

Get local views about local issues brought to the attention of the 'powers that be'

You only need to attend meetings, first Monday of each month except for July and August and help out with projects where you are able to
