Minutes of the meeting of Stackpole and Castlemartin Community Council held at Castlemartin Community Hall on Monday, September 5th 2022, at 7.30pm.

Update on current issues

- 1. Sustainable Freshwater west** – Councillor Edward Morris will email Stuart Berry to discuss the sustainable freshwater West project.
- 2. St. Twynnels Bus Shelter** – The community council will take on the bus shelter with a peppercorn rent from Pembrokeshire County Council. PCC is currently undergoing a recruitment drive and once a new surveyor is in post for this area the agreement will be finalised.
- 3. Parking Freshwater West, Bosherton, Stackpole Quay** – A multi-agency (Pembrokeshire County Council, National trust, National Park and Community Council) meeting has taken place on Friday the 26th August 22 to discuss how the parking issues have been over the busy summer months. The 28-day rule will be monitored. In Bosherton it is going to see if it can be negotiated with Pembrokeshire County Council to open the field belonging to Simon Davies using the 28-day rule.
- 4. Stackpole Church Hall** – No further developments an advertisement for the position of vicar was published on the 9th May 22 and the interviews are anticipated to be held on the 23rd of October 2022.
- 5. Notice Board Stackpole** – The councillors asked the clerk to enquire with Pembrokeshire County Council if it would be possible to move the location of the notice board to near the site of former telephone kiosk in Stackpole. It is anticipated that an advertisement consent application will be required. Once the clerk has conducted her enquiries and advertisement consent is given Councillor Haydn Garlick will reinstate the noticeboard.
- 6. Thorn Chapel sign** – The camp has agreed to provide an email with the firing times each month to be displayed in the village noticeboards. The councillors would still like a sign erected as people are still trying to drive to Stack Rocks when the road is closed. The councillors asked the clerk to contact Major Poole again.
- 7. Clerk CILCA Course** – The clerk has worked through Units three and four and will submit before the month end. The clerk will require an extension of three months to complete the course costing £50.
- 8. Warren Cross sign** – The sign at Warren Cross to St. Twynnels is missing. The matter has now been passed to Emrys Llewelyn of PCC who has ordered a new direction sign to St. Twynnels. At the time of the meeting the sign has yet to be replaced.
- 9. Bosherton No Coaches Sign** - Rob Evans of Pembrokeshire County Council is Arranging for an unsuitable for coaches sign to be installed near Windsor House at the village end of the road to the beach. Pembrokeshire County Council Officers have been to look at the location but the sign is yet to be erected.
- 10. White Salt like substance fly tipped at Freshwater West** – Marc Owen of Pembrokeshire County Council is going to arrange for the removal of the salt like substance.
- 11. Meadow Bank, St. Twynnels, Lighting Bollards** - The bollards have now been turned off during the day, however the light outside number 8 woodland Rise is now missing. The councillors asked the clerk to contact Pembrokeshire County Council to report the matter again.
- 12. Code of Conduct Training** – Joint community council code of conduct training has been arranged for Stackpole & Castlemartin, Hundleton and Angel community councillors. The training will take place on the 21st of September 2022 at 6.30 pm in Angle Church Hall.

- 13. ST. Petrox** - The councillors also asked the clerk to write to St. Petrox farm for feedback as there was a major accident where the road narrows and the community council feel signage would be of benefit in this area.
- 14. Penrhyn School Governor's** – The headmaster is retiring and the headmistress from St Florence will be working between the Penrhyn and St. Florence Schools. There was no further update at the time of the meeting.
- 15. Co-option of New Councillors** – The councillors co-opted Shirley Hammond-Williams of Bosherton and David Rees of Stackpole for the two councillor vacancies.
