The Community Council wished to make the following comments:

Farming diversification is important.

The opportunity to provide some biodiverse planting is important.

The business idea is a good one, but the location is not suitable.

The business should be sited away from residential properties.

Councillors are not confident that this business is being policed properly.

Residents are facing abuse and there is no credible resolution on the horizon to stop this happening.

The current regulations in place for the dog field are not being followed.

Noise is still an issue.

The Council was disappointed with the lack of response from the owners of the field to the feelings of the residents affected.

If the application were to be approved, the Community Council would like the following stipulations to be added: privacy fences to extend around the full perimeter; toilet facilities to be provided; enhanced biodiverse planting around the perimeter; strict monitoring of the booking system, the site and the opening hours of the facility.
