Dyfed Powys Police PC1189 commented that Tiers Cross Community Council (TCCC) have gone through tight routes in contacting GoSafe Wales. There are limited resources for speed camera but they will work to monitor the areas providing visibility. Dyfed Powys Police (DPP) will continue to plan presence in this area. It was noted that the roads are getting busier going through Tiers Cross volume as much as speed was more noticeable. All agreed increased presence and visibility would a good step forward. EJ commented speed seems to increase, when leaving the 20mph zone towards Haverfordwest, DPP enquired did we have any community speed watch at the moment in Tiers Cross as we could use a community speed gun this would be calibrated so a letter could be sent as a warning but no enforcement could take place.

	<p>The discussion then went on to note that's outside the quarry there is an increased danger as mud on the road also lorries turning in and out at peak period, leading to dangerous manoeuvres by drivers in a rush trying to overtake. DPP we asked if they could provide any support in this. TCCC are to get in touch with quarry and raise their concern. It was also noted that there used to be a liaison committee regarding the quarry DY was asked to contact the Quarry and see if there was still a community liaison group taking place with themselves. – Action DY to contact Quarry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Brambley Croft Update RO provided an update he had spoken to G Wade PCC who works within highways. There is a barn conversion on the entrance that needs to be completed before the road is completed on the site. There is a Sec 38 agreement with the developers so the road will be completed on the completion of the final property. LR enquired that as the Barn is on another postcode would that make a difference to the completion date? RO stated the completion of the road will not take place until all the properties are completed within that development. LR thanked for the update.
