Cllr Kidney reported, the county council have agreed a council tax rise of 12.5% alongside significant budget cuts including a 2% cut in the school's budget, closing all adult day centres (moving to a different model to support adults), £1.5 million was taken out of reserves which will need to be replaced.

Local Councils are pressing for progress on the Brynhir development.

Pembrokeshire CC Highways section reviewing the cutting schedule of hedgerows within the Penally community.
