123. Grass Verge opposite Abercych Hall – Highways department to redefine the verge in the summer. Was noted and welcomed.

124. Speed Watch at Abercych – Enquiry made to the Neighbourhood Policing Team who confirmed a public meeting would have to be held if a formal request for community speed monitoring was to be made for Abercych.

125. Inconsiderate Parking Newchapel by Taxis – Licensing department have been made aware of the issue regarding Home James Taxis parking without consideration for other road users.
