### 39. Minutes of the monthly meeting held on the 15/06/16

After circulation of the minutes, they were signed by the Chairman as a correct record. It was a unanimous decision proposed by Cllr Alan Ford and seconded by Cllr Liz Hall.

40. Removal of recycling bins – Following the matter raised by Cllr Sullivan it was confirmed that all the recycling bins remain in place at Abercych.

41. Verge at Porthycrwydryn crossroads. It was reported that the verge had been cut.

42. Update from Chairman regarding Abercych members conducting a spring clean session for Abercych. It was reported that one session had taken place.

43. Email from Louise Moore regarding maintenance of the Millennium Garden. It was agreed not to pay the requested sum as no instruction had been made. Members would monitor the maintenance of the garden by the Clynyfw farm group.

49. Discussion ensued regarding the very late night discharge of Fireworks by patrons of Abercych Village Hall sometime in June. A number of complaints had been received from residents. It was reported that lessons had been learned and future hire of the hall would have rigorous conditions.
