FINANCE/CYLLID

Councillors agreed to pay P.C.C. invoice for servicing Nevern Village Public Toilets 1st July/30th September 2016 - £529.39 including £88.23 VAT.

NEVERN CASTLE

All Councillors had received a report of the Castle site meeting held on the 9th November 2016 (not 2015 as stated on the report heading) Plus the recently installed steps requiring extra filling lead to the "square tower".

After a detailed discussion it was unanimously agreed to continue with the Castle website including payment of the £30 domaine fee, and the site operators expenses £150. Cllr. Peter Davies will contact Mr. Huw Roberts, Castle Farm.

Cllr. Peter Davies drew attention to the need to provide supports for the "Marker Posts", and to obtain Mr. Richard Bennett's address in order that he can be reminded of his obligation to maintain the Throne etc.

The trees overhanging the roadside need trimming - possibly using a Contractor, and the ivy needs to be cut off the tree near Dolau. Plus two trees at the entrance need removing.
