5) Matters Arising

Highways, Ditches and Roads

The Clerk was urged to follow up with Cllr Lewis and the county cc to Mr Percy.

Damage to road from farm vehicles was noted by Mr Nutting from Uzmaston to Norchard area where many residents are dependent on carers.

Planning Enforcement

Clerk has telephoned and emailed PCNPA for an update. The DM team responded that the member of staff responsible is making enquiries will be in touch shortly. Clerk to pursue.

Broadband Letter

Mr Thomas had received a reply from Mr Wyyr Roberts (BT Broadband Wales & Marches) and the case will be put to Welsh Government for UBS be put forward for investment. Miss Thomas had been informed that the area was in scope. Mr Thomas had written to Paul Davies asking that our case is made (cc Simon Hart).

Mr Nutting (member of the public) asked how applicable this is for householders? Mr Thomas reported that the new box would improve speed at Orchard and other more remote communities. Miss Thomas has offered for cable to be laid across her fields. Cost to extend to Norchard junction is estimated at £500,000.

Noticeboard

The Clerk has investigated prices and styles of noticeboard from commercial specialist suppliers. The prices and designs vary considerably and the Clerk recommended Members agree budget and design prior to submitting a formal request for siting from PCC. Members asked the Clerk to seek prices from local joiners.

Parking on Pavements at Addison Rd

The Clerk had prepared a letter from the Community Council to be delivered to households at Addison Rd asking them to take care to park safely.

Poor state of pavement in New Road

The pavement repair is inadequate on the main pedestrian route into town and needs attention but Members were anxious to preserve trees.
