Following a discussion it was proposed to keep the precept at the same level as proposed by Cllr Keith and seconded by Cllr Gwenfair Mason.

7. County Councillor's Report

- Cllr Simson reported that there had been an incident in the village with grease having been smeared over the kissing gate by a grease gun. David tried to clean it off with hot water but PCC have now been out to clean it up. The person who reported it to David had her coat covered in grease and now the incident has been reported to the police and a crime number has been issued.
- Light reported on junction by the bridge in the village
- Welsh Government decided that a review of electoral areas will start in 2017 and end in 2019 for council election in 2022.
- Plenblewin road into Narberth speed restriction - work started last week and speed will be reduced to 50mph. Ludchurch and Princes Gate will be reduced to 30mph and work should start in the next two months.
