MATTERS ARISING/MATERION YN CODI

A copy of the Consultation Version - February 2017 Well Being Assessment for Pembrokeshire has been received, and will be available to interested Councillors at the April Meeting

PLANNING/CYNLLUNIAU

NP/16/0392/FUL Councillors noted that the N.P. have approved the partial demolition of an agricultural building & re-construction as an ancillary building to the private residence subject to lighting conditions & incidental use only by the dwelling house known as Penwaun, also this building cannot be used as a self contained residential unit or tourist accomodation.

NP/17/0075/FUL Councillors examined this second application from Newport Golf Club to extend a one-bedroom apartment to two bedroom plus dining room apartment by linkage to a former laundry room. No objections were raised.

NP/17/0089/LBA Councillors considered the application from Ivy Cottage, Nevern for a replacemet door and cladding + new pattern of French doors to be an improvement, and raised no objections.

Paul Davies AM advised that he has written to Mr. Ken Skates AM Cabinet Secretary for Economy & Infrastructure requesting he investigates our many requests going back over ten years for ensuring the 40mph speed limit through Felindre Farchog is adhered to.
