



Angle Community Council Minutes 4th July 2018 at 18.30

1. Matters arising:

1. West Angle Bay Car parking.

Cllr Hill reported that he, John Allen-Mirehouse and County Cllr M Bateman met with Cllr Baker (chair of County Council Transportation and Roads committee). There was a feeling that Cllr Baker was understanding of the situation. There are several procedural hurdles to overcome before a final decision re approving a variation order.

It was felt that it would be helpful to have letters of support from local businesses (Wavecrest, Chapel Fort).

2. Clerk Vacancy

3. Footpath hedge cutting and signage

Concern that the hedge has grown significantly and needs of cutting prior to the summer holidays. Also, clarity on positioning of signage. Concern re overgrown hedging from Small dock at west angle bay to corner of West Pill house was raised. This is causing problem re access especially disability / pram access.

2. **Adoption of West Bay Close by PCC.** Cllr Bateman has made several phone calls, but progress slow.
