18. Minutes of the monthly meeting and AGM held on the 13/05/14

19. Final Audit submitted 4th June 2014 and verified as correct by Council's internal auditor – was noted.

20. Annual Dinner – Chairman's allowance £74.80p. The payment of the sum was approved. Members also thanked County Cllr John Davies for his generosity in funding most of the wine.

21. Flowers delivered and installed for flower beds and hanging baskets. £20 paid to Richard Wilson and £60 paid to Mr David Trem for four hanging baskets. Both payments were approved for payment. An invoice from the County Council for the flowers is awaited.

Correspondence

22. Post Office - Temporary branch Closure - Abercych as of 29 July 2014 – Regrettably members noted with disappointment the prospects of the closure of the part time Post Office at Abercych.

Reports

23. County Councillor's report – County Cllr Davies reported that the speed reduction scheme for Newchapel would be finalised in July. Members were asked to approve a draft signage plan for the scheme. Members were happy to support the new signage.

Financial Matter

24. Balance as of 10/06/14 net of all outstanding cheques – Treasures Acc £2,557.43p – The balance was seen and noted.

25. Members were informed that a cheque for £50 payable for the 2013/14 rental of Abercych Hall had been lost. It was agreed to reissue a new cheque to replace the lost cheque. It was further noted that this situation is regrettable given this is not the first time a cheque has been lost to the same payees.

26. Cllr Ford shared with the members the concern of the Abercych Village Association regarding the difficulty the association were experiencing in attracting new users for the village hall.

27. A request for the use of the Newchapel playing field for the Annual sports event on the 26th of July was approved with no charge to be levied.
