Minutes of the meeting of Templeton Community Council

Held in the Templeton Hall, Templeton on 7th March 2019

1) To accept apologies for absence. None were received..

Cllr Priest then briefly spoke about a potential open evening to gather the input of the village for Hall and other developments, around the topic of Templeton past and future. It was agreed that this should be taken forward as a means of gathering interest and support for future developments.
