

Minutes of the meeting of Stackpole and Castlemartin Community Council held at Bosherton Church Hall on Tuesday, May 8th 2018, at 7.30pm.

Update on current issues

1. **Dip in the road at Stackpole:** PCC will arrange for this to be cut out and reinstated. At the time of the meeting this had not been completed the councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up again.
2. **Freshwater West Bridge:** Councillor Alderman asked the clerk to write to the highways department at PCC and request a weight sign with a red triangle to prevent heavy vehicles going down over the bridge and send a copy to Angle Community Council. The sign has been installed at the top of the hill. The councillors asked the clerk to ask for a similar sign to be installed on the Southside.
3. **Chapel Hill Hedge:** The hedge at Chapel Hill requires cutting back Neil Batchelor has promised to cut the hedge back. This has not been completed at the time of the meeting but will be carried out in the near future.
4. **Pembroke Comprehensive Bus Route -** Councillor David Edwards asked the clerk to contact Pembroke Comprehensive School and see if the rural bus route covering Stackpole could be changed as pupils from Stackpole are on the bus for one hour in the morning and one hour in the evening. There has been no response from the school, in light of this the councillors asked the clerk to contact Tess Hodgson.
5. **Deerpark View -** Councillor Peter Nicholas asked the clerk to contact the highways department at Pembrokeshire County Council to re fix the road sign for Deerpark View next to the bus stop as it is barely hanging on. At the time of the meeting the sign had not been repaired the councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up again.
6. **Coach House Toilets -** The councillors asked the clerk to contact Pembroke Town council about the public toilets next to the Coach House being closed. The toilets have now been reopened they were closed due to vandalism.
7. **Stackpole VC School -** sale no news.
8. **St. Twynells Bus Shelter -** Councillor Edward Morris asked the clerk to contact Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council in relation to repairs required at St. Twynells bus shelter.

9. **Bosherston Grit Bin** - The councillors asked the clerk to check with Kay West who has the key for the grit bin in Bosherston. The grit bin is unlocked.
10. **Hayston Lane** -The councillors asked the clerk to write to Castlemartin army camp to put a sign up for Hayston Lane as army vehicles are going up to Hayston.
11. **Penrhyn School Zebra Crossing** - The councillors asked the clerk to contact Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council and request a pedestrian crossing and lollipop person to assist the children to cross the road at the new Penrhyn School. Councillor Haydn Garlic attended the governors meeting on the 14th March 2018. The governors have written to Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council requesting a zebra crossing and an extended 30 mph speed limit. The councillors asked the clerk to write a letter of support to Darren Thomas for Hundleton Community Council. Councillor Margot Bateman spoke to Darren Thomas and Phil Bateman and raised the question about a zebra crossing at cabinet. At cabinet it was discussed about having chicanes either side. The council will be installing a raised level crossing.
12. **Dogs running around Stackpole Village** - The councillors received complaints about two small dogs running around the village of Stackpole the clerk was asked to contact the dog warden.
13. **Stackpole VC School Car Park** - Councillor David Edwards asked the clerk to contact Darren Thomas to find out the status of the old school car park is it now a public carpark. Darren Thomas confirmed the carpark is not a public carpark.
