#### **Update on current issues**

- 1. Stackpole VC School-sale no further updates at the time of the meeting.
- **2. St. Twynnells Bus Shelter –**. Helen McLeod-Baikie is looking into the cost of the lease. The councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up with Helen.
- **3.** Buckspool Farm Pot Hole No further update at the time of the meeting.
- **4. Street Lights –**The streetlight opposite Windsor House in Castlemartin has not yet been repaired.
- **5. Fly Tipping** The fly tipping has chucked into Valence hill the councillors asked the clerk to report the matter to PCC again.
- **6. Pot Hole –** Between Stackpole and Cheriton bottom, the councillors asked the clerk to chase the matter up again with PCC.
- 7. Visually Assisted Sign the councillors are looking into funding options for a visually assisted sign to be put in the village of Stackpole to encourage the traffic to slow down.
- **8. Woodland Rise Street Light –** Still not working the councillors asked the clerk to report to PCC again.
- **9.** The Pound Castlemartin The councillors requested the clerk to contact CADW in relation to funding to replace the sign.
- **10. Brownslade –** The councillors asked the clerk to contact Emrys Llewellyn re still water at the bottom of Brownslade and request a trench to be dug.
