## **NOTICE OF CO-OPTION**

The Returning Officer of Pembrokeshire County Council has confirmed that the regulation 10 requests from Electors has not been fulfilled and that Angle Community Council can now fill the casual vacancy by co-option.

Applicants will be invited to attend the next available community council meeting and to make a short (3-5 minutes) personal statement giving the reasons for being interested in joining the Community Council and what particular set of skills and experience they feel they can bring to the role.

## Eligibility and Qualifications to become a Community Councillor

A person is qualified to be elected and to be a Community Councillor if they are a British, Commonwealth, Irish or European Citizen and on the relevant day that is, the day of nomination or election they are 18 or over.

In addition, the person must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1) They much must be on the Electoral Register for Angle
- 2) During the whole of the twelve months prior to the relevant day they have occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the community of Angle.
- **3)** During the whole of the twelve months before the relevant day his/her principal or only place of work in the community of Angle.
- 4) During the whole of the twelve months before the relevant day resided in the locality or within three miles of it.

Certain people are disqualified from standing, and these include paid officers of the Community Council, anyone subject to bankruptcy restriction orders and those subject to recent sentences of imprisonment.
