







PUBLIC EXHIBITIONS

Greenlink is a proposed electricity interconnector that will link the GB electricity system in Pembrokeshire with that of Ireland via underground and subsea cables.

It is proposed that the subsea cables will come onshore at Freshwater West (under the existing dunes and beach), carry on underground in the direction of Pembroke Substation, where they will connect to a new purpose-built converter station.

Technical and environmental survey work has now been completed with feedback from stakeholders incorporated into the latest proposals.

The Greenlink team would like to discuss and present the latest information, including:

- The final submitted Marine Licence application documents which are currently being assessed by Natural Resources Wales and subject to formal consultation ending 8th January; and
- The draft Environmental Impact Assessment and draft planning application documents for the onshore components of Greenlink.

Greenlink brings significant benefits on both sides of the Irish Sea for employment, energy security and the integration of low carbon energy sources.

We are committed to working with local residents and stakeholders to design and develop a project that is of the highest standard. We would welcome your input throughout the development process.
