

Minutes of the meeting of Stackpole and Castlemartin Community Council held at Castlemartin Community Hall on Monday, March 2nd 2020, at 7.30pm.

Update on current issues

1. **Stackpole VC School**- There has been some vandalism within the school during February 2020.
2. **St. Twynells Bus Shelter** – The Councillors are looking at the possibility of applying for funding to repair the bus shelter via the Community Works Grant.
3. **Buckspool Farm Pot Hole** – The Councillors decided to review the pot hole in the summer.
4. **Pot Hole Cheriton** – The pot hole has not yet been repaired the councillors asked the clerk to contact Pembrokeshire County Council again to request the pothole to be repaired.
5. **Visually Assisted Sign** - The councillors are looking at the possibility of applying for funding for VAS signs via the Community Works Grant and have asked the clerk to obtain quotations for the cost of a sign to be installed at the entrance of the village of Stackpole.
6. **The Pound Castlemartin** – Councillor Alderman awaiting the cost of a cast iron replacement sign.
7. **Brownslade** – Councillor Alderman has taken photographs and the matter has been passed onto Steve Benger of Pembrokeshire County Council.
8. **St Twynells Play Area** – Darren Thomas of Pembrokeshire County Council has referred the matter to environmental services and the hedge will be cut back next week.
9. **Sleeping Policemen** – No further update at the time of the meeting.
10. **Road signs** - Pembrokeshire County Council has stated that the area supervisor will check the bent road sign at Chapel Hill and the road narrows sign just before the property Creature leading into Bosherton and arrange for repairs.
11. **Fly Tipping Gilead** – The fly tipping has been removed.
12. **Army Tanks** – The councillors have received complaints about the tanks on Castlemartin Straights.
13. **Cheriton Post Box** – The councillors have received complaints regarding people parking on the walkway slabs by the post box in Cheriton and elderly people are having difficulty accessing the post box.
14. **Fly Tipping** – The Councillors have received complaint that a large quantity of tyres have been dumped at Marledge bottoms.
15. **East End Square Toilets** – The councillors asked the clerk to contact Pembroke Town Council in relation to the public toilets in East End Square being closed.
16. **Penrhyn School Parking** – The councillors have received complaints about car parking problems at Penrhyn School in Hundleton.
