

**PUBLIC NOTICE PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2)
TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT VARIOUS ROADS, ANGLE**

NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

The proposed Order is necessary so that carriageway realignment work can be carried out to a section of the B4320 at the junction of the B4320 / C3101, Angle.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a temporary speed limit on those lengths of road specified in the schedule to this notice to prohibit any motor vehicle to drive at a speed in excess of either a 40mph, 30mph or 10mph speed limit (the level set will be dependent on the type of work being carried out at that time).

It is intended that these restrictions, which will be signed accordingly will come into effect on Monday 7th December and remain in force until the works have been completed or until such time as a permanent speed limit is introduced.

SCHEDULE 1 – TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT

Road	Length
B4320	From a point 120 metres west of its junction with C3101 to a point 175m East
C3101	From a point 175 metres north of its junction with the B4320.
