The Council do not consider that this application is, at this point in time, acceptable development. The Council understand the requirement and support the need for unused farm barns to be utilised in other ways, but do not consider that the proposed plans are in keeping with the surrounding area or the existing building. The glass windows are in no way sympathetic to the old building's existing character. Cllr Hall proposed that Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Planning Authority consider this application for refusal, but advise that Manorbier Community Council would consider any alterations in the application to accommodate Mr R Scourfield's and the Councils comments; Cllr Long seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

The Council to request if a much more ascetically pleasing site may be found.
